		All photography styles and are welcome and winners will be selected by a blind jury of professionals in the arts.		
		There will be six categories that align with the San Jose Dublin Sister City Program's mission and will include:		
		CIVIC Of or relating to a city or town, especially its administration, including the duties or activities of people in relation to their city, town or local area.		
		ATHLETIC Of or relating to athletes or athletics, including sporting events and people who are physically strong, fit, and active.		
		Of or relating to the ideas, customs and social behavior of San Jose society, be it ethnic, societal; lifestyle, the arts and intellectual achievements.		
		ECONOMIC Images relating to economics or the economy in San Jose.		
		ARTISTIC Images characteristic of San Jose art or artistry that are aesthetically pleasing, expressive, creative and imaginative.		
		EDUCATIONAL Of or relating to the provision of education, images that serve to educate or enlighten academic or scholastic learning or teaching.		

Each category will have three winners selected for first, second and third place, along with two or more honorable mention selections. One submission will be awarded Best in Show
